Through nine assessment themes, and underpinned by the Level 5 Diploma in Education and training, the programme will aid the development of a high-performing workforce. The themes show how the specific skills, knowledge and behaviours criteria, within the standard, underpin the 9 thematic (synoptic) aspects of the Learning and Skills Teacher role.

These themes are driven by government policy, Ofsted expectations and evidence-based practice. They inform the structure of the synoptic End-Point Assessment and, in particular but not exclusively, the Thematic Case Study and Teaching Observations.

Teachers and employers will need to consider how to integrate these 9 themes in all aspects of on-programme development and formative assessment.
